**Purpose:**

**Policy:** Although withdrawal from classes is normally the responsibility of each student, circumstances may require and/or permit that the College administration exercise that responsibility for the student. Examples of such circumstances might include non-payment of tuition and fees, falsification of information used in determining admission eligibility, failure to attend classes or prolonged cessation of attendance, serious illness/injury resulting in physical/mental incapacitation, legal incarceration, disciplinary action resulting in suspension or expulsion, military call-up, or death. In such cases, the appropriate department will exercise that authority and responsibility on behalf of the institution and in the best interests of the student.
